Here are some things you should include to make it accessible for people with disabilities and/or autism...

- Someone with a disability or autism on the organising **committee**
- Separate **tickets** or **wristbands** for disabled/autistic attendees
- **Easy read** information that includes times, locations, costs, how to get there and what to do about food and drink
- Free tickets for **carers/support workers**
- Quiet '**breakout**' areas with subtle lighting
- **Seating** areas and raised platforms - no stairs!
- Accessible **toilets** that are regularly checked
- A sign language or Makaton **interpreter**
